

The Corporation of the Municipality of Highlands East

Bylaw # 2018-60

Being a bylaw to provide for the naming and renaming of the highways, streets, roads and private roads within the Municipality of Highlands East.

Whereas Section 48 of the Municipal Act, 2001. S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended, authorizes the Council of local municipalities to pass bylaws giving names to or changing the names of highways and for affixing the names at the corners thereof, on public or private property;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Highlands East has adopted bylaw #2011-10 being a bylaw to adopt a Policy for the Giving of Public Notice, that provides for one notice in a local paper, a minimum of ten (10) days prior to the date of passing a bylaw for change and or naming of the highways, streets, roads and private roads within the Municipality of Highlands East;

And Whereas the County of Haliburton has provided an updated complete road name list (including water access);

Now therefore the Council of the Municipality of Highlands East enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the “Road Naming Bylaw” of the Corporation of the Municipality of Highlands East.
2. All highways / streets / roads in the Municipality of Highlands East shall be named and / or known according to “Schedule A” ,“Schedule B” and “Schedule C” attached to this Bylaw.
3. Schedule “A” , “B” and “C” attached form part of this bylaw.
4. The Municipality is hereby authorized to affix street name signs at the corners of every highway / street / road, on public and private property, subject to the jurisdictions and the requirements of the County or the Ministry of Transportation.
5. All road name signs at intersections shall include the approved road name. Where new signs are to be erected, the sign shall include the approved road name and the direction and sequencing of property numbering.
6. Should any section, clause or provision in this Bylaw held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Bylaw shall not be affected.
7. Any bylaw or parts of by-laws inconsistent with this Bylaw, or names of streets in registered plans inconsistent with this Bylaw, are hereby deemed repealed.
8. That Bylaw # 2014-37 and # 2016-01 is hereby rescinded.

Read a first, second and third time, and finally passed this 4th day of July, 2018.
