**FYI:** Hockey skates are allowed until elementary level. Skating lessons are excellent for little hockey players.

Each evening will begin with a 10 minute warm up. Group lessons will then begin according to skill level with the newer skaters first and ending with the more advanced skaters.

Senior skaters are encouraged to help coach the juniors. They can earn volunteer hours for this.

**Rules:** There are not a lot of rules to skating lessons. Basically you and your child are asked to respect the coach and the volunteer helpers, dress your child appropriately so he/she can participate fully and be on time for your lesson. Please encourage children to stay on the ice during skating time to minimize distractions.

The little children should wear helmets and we ask that there be no gum chewing or hard candies while skating.
