5. a) T37
-Pete and Barry discussed T37 and putting together a letter to HCDC & MNRF outlining the work that will be done. Tenders will be going out next week.

b) Haliburton Fish Hatchery

c) Update McCrea Road Allowance
The trail committee was provided a copy of the completed McCrea Road allowance survey. The committee inquired on whether or not the surveyor crossed the Watham Trail and if they brushed the road allowance during their survey. Joanne to obtain copies of the survey for the Committee.
6. Trail Extension Project

The Paudash Snowmobile Club trail 608 is 0.9 kms. Private property owners have asked that the trail be moved however, the municipality has provided permission to utilize the road allowance for this trail. Local traffic uses this trail to gain access to gas station and restaurant in Wilberforce; traffic comes from Haliburton Club to the west and as well as the clubs to the south. This could be a joint use trail and great opportunity to develop. Club volunteers are ready to clear trees, brush the trail and put up signage. The terrain is fairly level throughout the length of the proposed trail. The Paudash snowmobile Club have asked the Committee to recommend to Council from the Trail Committee for survey costs to be covered by a Municipal Fund.

That the Trail Committee recommend to Council to provide \$4,700 for the road allowance survey costs for the 608 trail expansion and further be funded from the Trail Committee Reserves. Moved by Dale, Seconded by Barry.

7. Water trail proposed brochure

The Committee requests that we receive a quote from Jodi Rupnow to create a map using this format and our GPS data and her knowledge of the Irondale River Trail. Dale is willing to assist with the map creation.
